The State Board is getting ready for 2018 Council which will be held at Harford County Community College in Bel Air on Saturday, June 9th.

As the League of Women Voters is approaching the 100th year anniversary of our founding, we've naturally grown self-reflective. This self-reflection has sparked difficult conversations around the tough decisions that must be made to ensure the efficacy and impact of the League in its second century. The results of these discussions are summarized in the LWV Transformation Roadmap. We have dedicated a good portion of 2018 Biennial Council to this topic and document.
